These notes are designed to describe the road concerned. They are made at slow speed. Bumps and jumps at rally pace must be treated with your own judgement. It is up to each individual to ascertain his own car/ suspension/tyre/speed capabilities. It is up to each driver to assess the relevance of each feature with those before and after. As these notes are designed for a wide cross-section of drivers in differing cars, it is essential that you bear this in mind. Also, holes, rocks, mud, floods and fallen trees/logs etc. can appear. The onus is on you to check starts/finishes/junctions/chicanes etc. We comply when making the notes with the original information supplied by the organisers, but cannot guarantee on the day of the rally that the set-up will be exactly the same. 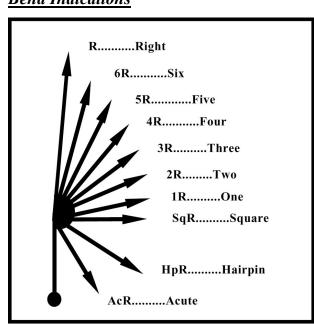

Linking everything are distances in yards - even numbers up to 100 (40, 60, 80), odd numbers over that (130, 150, 170, 250). Short distances will be \Rightarrow (into) or (and) +. Into means that the steering wheel will just about straighten between two corners, + (and) will be longer - 20/30 yards. A line under a number of symbols means that they should be read quickly and together, to let the driver know what is coming up in good time. Also used to emphasise a note. The little boxes in the

left hand margin denote junctions, with the Radio Point above where applicable, the distance to the finish is in brackets
